We understand that there is a lot going on in Term 4 and if you are in need of a payment plan please come and see us in the Admin Office.

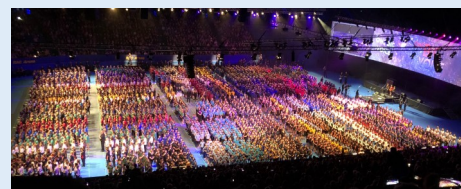
## Enrolments & Students Leaving
