



Kindy and Pre-Primary Applications Close Friday 24 July 2020

You need to apply to enrol your children in public school for 2021 if they are:

- Starting Kindergarten – 4 years old by 30th June 2021
- Starting Pre-primary, the first year of compulsory school – 5 years old by 30 June 2021
- Starting Year 7, the first year of secondary school
- Changing schools

Information and Communication Technology additions

Rooms 1 and 3 have just received 32 Asus Chromebooks. These were funded by the school at a cost of \$18,000. The students will be using Microsoft365, One Point and the cloud to enhance learning and build skills in the lead up to transitioning to high school. The children and Mrs Dawson were very excited to make use of them today.



The new classroom, Room 5 has received a Promethean ActivPanel Nickel. Teachers and students can collaborate with up to 15 simultaneous touch points. Palm rejection technology allows users to rest a hand naturally on the board and write confidently without making unwanted marks. ActivPanel Nickel's controlled, multi-device mirroring lets teachers move freely and teach from anywhere in the classroom. During a lesson, the teacher can interact with shared screens directly from the ActivPanel, increasing student collaboration and participation. Miss Pedersen and the Year 1's are making excellent use of the panel.
